

### Day 1-Thursday November 29th

Sit back and relax as we head to Gettysburg and the Courtyard by Marriott. After checking in we will depart for the **Historic Farnsworth House**. You will enjoy this colonial restaurant where candlelight elegance, colonial and continental cuisine bring back the sight, sounds, and tastes of two centuries ago. We will return to the hotel for the evening after dinner.

### Day 2-Friday November 30th

This morning we will visit the **Gettysburg Museum and Visitor Center**. This building houses the Museum with over 22,000 square feet of relics from the **Battle of Gettysburg** as well as interactive exhibits and multi-media presentations. You will also see the film, **"A New Birth of Freedom"** narrated by award winning actor **Morgan Freeman**. The **Cyclorama painting of Pickett's Charge** is also included. It's off to DC and lunch at the **Hard Rock Cafe** followed by a visit to the new **Museum of the Bible**. This facility houses the worlds largest private collections of biblical objects and artifacts. Next is the **Vietnam Wall, the Lincoln Memorial, and the Korean War Memorial** before checking in to the **Gaylord National Resort**. After getting settled in you can enjoy complimentary cocktails in Pose or the Belvedere Lounge. You will also receive unlimited visits to **"ICE"** as well as a ride on the **Capital Wheel**.

### Day 3-Saturday December 1st

After picking up our guide this morning we will tour the **Mansion on O Street**. With it's **100 uniquely themed rooms and 70 secret doors**, it's sure to impress. After lunch at **King St. Blues** and a driving tour of Embassy Row, we'll arrive at **Hillwood Estate**. This mansion is the former home of cereal heiress Marjorie Merriweather Post and features one of the most comprehensive collections of eighteenth and nineteenth century Russian Imperial art. We will also tour the **National Aquarium** in Baltimore this afternoon followed by some free time at the **Baltimore Christmas Markets** modeled after the famous Christkindl Market in Germany. Dinner this evening is at **Gordon Biersch Brewery Restaurant**.

### Day 4-Sunday December 2nd

Today will start with a tour of **Ford's Theater and Peterson House**, the home across the street from the theatre where Lincoln was carried after he was shot. This will be followed with a holiday lunch cruise aboard the *Spirit of Washington*. This afternoon will also bring us to the **Newseum**, the only interactive museum of news. A tour of **Madame Tussauds Wax Museum** awaits before we have dinner at **Buca Di Beppo** followed by an **Illuminated Monument Driving Tour** before returning to the hotel for the evening.

### Day 5-Monday December 3rd

We will arrive at **Mount Vernon at Christmas** time this morning. Here George Washington escaped the rigors of public office and enjoyed the life of a successful Virginia planter. America's most visited historic house, Mount Vernon sits on a grassy, shaded slope overlooking the Potomac River. Mount Vernon is both George and Martha Washingtons home and final resting place. We will head to the Flight 93 Memorial in Pennsylvania before checking into our hotel in Ligonier. Dinner will be at the hotel this evening.
